**Abstract**

*In order to control changes, rush times, tension and situations like that in organizations, managers, workers, and colleagues at work should know and recognize the sources, indicators, and consequences of stress, and predisposition to stress of different psychological types. Knowledge of stress predisposition is of use also in work allocation in organizations as well as in individual occupational orientation. In this paper, the relationship between stress profiles and types will be analyzed. The basic question is: Are certain types more sensitive to stress than some others, as could be assumed on the basis of the descriptions of the types. Stress indicators related to personal characteristics and work characteristics will be considered.*
