Abstract

This study examined the psychological type distribution of Finnish Business Students and their favorite occupations by temperaments. The total sample was mainly ESTJs (22%), ENTJs (15%), ENTPs (10%) and ISTJs (10%). At the temperament level there were 38% SJs, 35% NTs, 18% NFs and 9% SPs. In comparison with the Atlas tables, NTs and SJs followed more faithfully the same lines as the Atlas with regard to occupations. The greatest differences were at the SP level. SPs had chosen occupations which are not so favored according to the Atlas tables. These differences may be caused by the selection of business students.
